

I-495 Express Lanes Northern Extension Project Timeline









Design Updates Live Oak Drive

- New Live Oak Drive bridge will be built south of existing bridge
- New bridge location minimizes disruption and allows existing I-495 retaining wall to remain in place during construction
- Design ensures no increase in stormwater flows to sensitive stream outfall that drains through Live Oak community










Typical Section of Realigned Live Oak Drive

- Updated design for Live Oak
 Drive based on public input,
 engineering considerations and
 efforts to reduce impacts
- Existing noise wall shifted to the west
- Improvements to occur mostly within VDOT right-of-way





(shown with orange line)








Proposed Noise Wall on Live Oak Drive




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
Live Oak Drive Pavement Shift on Eastern Side of Roadway

Design Noise Analysis Process

- Final noise analysis to be completed in summer 2022
- Based on design plans and updated traffic:
 - Is the wall warranted?
 - Is the wall feasible?
 - Is the wall reasonable?
- Publish final noise study results and proposed noise wall locations on 495NEXT.org



Example of dry stack (simulated stone) noise wall

- If construction impacts an existing wall, a replacement wall will be provided
- For new walls, input will be solicited from benefited property owners and renters (voting process)
- Include approved noise walls into final plans





Live Oak Drive Construction Milestones

Live Oak Drive I-495 bridge

- Begin construction: Summer 2022
- Complete new bridge and transfer traffic: 2024
- Demolition of old bridge: 2024

Live Oak Drive shift to west

- Begin construction: Summer 2022
- Complete construction: 2024
- Begin demolition of existing sound barriers/construction of new barriers: Fall 2022
- Complete construction of new sound barriers: 2023





What Residents Can Expect During 2022-23 Construction

Trees and other vegetation on both sides of existing Live Oak Drive will be

removed as needed to shift the road

 Periodic single-lane traffic with flaggers required to shift Live Oak Drive

 Live Oak Drive will be shifted within the limits of VDOT right of way, but the realignment will impact certain properties that have extended onto the right of way



Single-lane traffic operation on Live Oak Drive during January 2022 test boring







Upcoming Georgetown Pike Bridge Construction

- Following demolition of bridge median and placement of temporary barrier, traffic in both directions will be shifted slightly south on the bridge
- Purpose: Prepare for demolition of northern portion of bridge
- Work begins on/about June 1
- Periodic lane closures will be implemented during non-peak travel periods
- Completion of Georgetown Pike bridge replacement: 2024

Georgetown Pike - Bridge








Upcoming Left-Shoulder Lane Closure on I-495

- Permanent Closure of northbound left shoulder (green arrow/red X) lane between end of current 495 Express Lanes and GW Parkway
- Restriping and realignment to the outside of four lanes of I-495 in same section of Beltway
- Purpose: Create space in the center of the Beltway to construct bridge piers at Old Dominion Drive, Georgetown Pike and Live Oak Drive
- Work to begin on/about May 31-June 1 overnight
- Temporary barriers will be placed to secure the center work zone for the safety of travelers and workers



Maryland and Virginia Coordination

Maryland and Virginia working together to coordinate Maryland's Phase 1 South project and Virginia's 495 NEXT project

Key Elements:

- Provide a new American Legion Bridge and new bicycle and pedestrian access to connect trails on both sides of Potomac River.
- Final agreement will define how Maryland and Virginia projects will "interface" including:
 - Design and construction requirements
 - Operations and maintenance roles
 - Seamless regional dynamic toll lane network with each state operating its system independently
