

Opening November 22, the 495 Express Lanes Extension is a two-and-a-half-mile expansion of the current 495 Express Lanes north to near the George Washington Memorial Parkway. New entry and exit points will connect the Extension to the general purpose lanes and nearby major roads.

NEW ACCESS POINTS

1 Dulles Toll Road

Drivers traveling eastbound or westbound on Dulles Toll Road (Route 267) can directly access the northbound 495 Express Lanes.

2 George Washington Memorial Parkway

Northbound 495 Express Lanes drivers can exit directly onto the George Washington Memorial Parkway, while drivers on the George Washington Memorial Parkway can enter the southbound 495 Express Lanes.

ACCESS CHANGES

Northbound

Once drivers exit the northbound 495 Express Lanes to the general purpose lanes, drivers cannot exit the Beltway until after crossing the American Legion Bridge. To reach Georgetown Pike from the northbound Express Lanes, drivers should use a different exit.

Southbound

Southbound general purpose lane drivers who want to enter the Express Lanes must get on just after the American Legion Bridge. To get on the Express Lanes from Georgetown Pike, drivers should use a different entry ramp.
