Overnight Pile Driving Planned for July 29-31

What's Happening?

Pile driving is scheduled to occur during overnight hours (10 p.m. to 5 a.m.) July 29 through 31, near the northbound I-495 bridge over the ramp from the eastbound Dulles Toll Road to northbound I-495. The pile driving work is necessary to build the foundations for a portion of the new bridge (shown in teal on the map).

Pile driving in this tightly constricted location requires the closure of the existing ramp from eastbound Dulles Toll Road to northbound I-495, which can only occur during overnight hours to ensure the safety of work crews and travelers. Eastbound Toll Road traffic will be detoured onto southbound Route 7 to eastbound Route 123 to either direction of I-495 or to re-enter the Toll Road east of I-495. Pile driving for the bridge that does not require the ramp closure will be performed during daylight hours over the following one to two months.



What Should Neighbors Expect?

Pile driving involves hammering steel piles into the ground to support the foundation of the future bridge. When active, neighbors will hear hammer strikes every few seconds.
