



## NOTICE TO RESIDENTS NEAR OLD DOMINION DRIVE BRIDGE IN MCLEAN

Daytime Pile Driving for Old Dominion Drive Bridge  
Planned for March 18-19, April 3-16

I-495 Express Lanes Northern Extension (495 NEXT) Project

### What's Happening?

Pile driving to construct the eastern abutment of the new Old Dominion Drive bridge over the Capital Beltway is planned to occur in two upcoming phases:

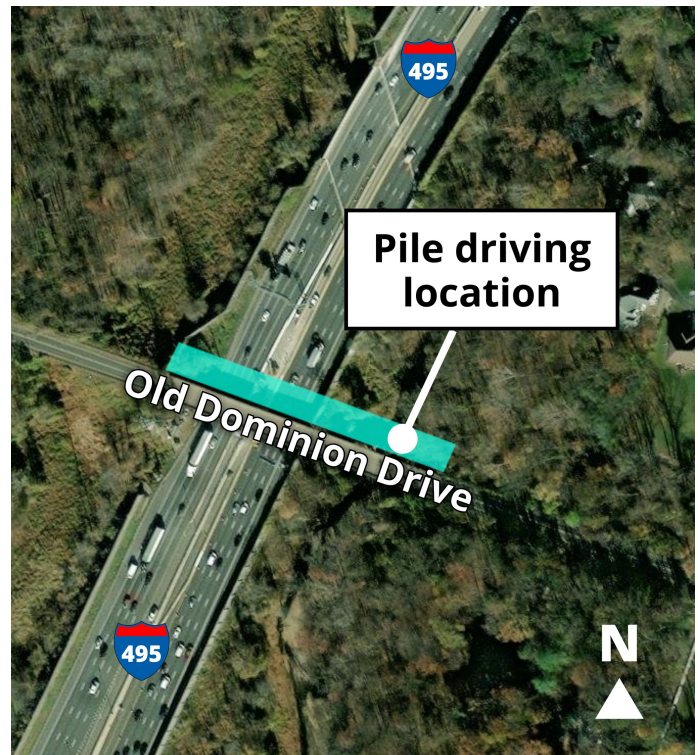
- **March 18-19**
- **April 3-16**

Pile driving will occur on weekdays during daytime hours.

### What Should Neighbors Expect?

Pile driving involves hammering steel piles into the ground to support the foundation of the future bridge. When active, neighbors will hear hammer strikes every few seconds.

All construction is dependent on weather conditions and other factors.



*Two phases of pile driving will occur along northbound I-495 for the Old Dominion Drive Bridge that is under construction. The teal rectangle represents where the new bridge will be located.*
