# **NOTICE TO NEIGHBORS**

Daytime Pile Driving for New Georgetown Pike Bridge Planned to Start on or About May 22

I-495 Express Lanes Northern Extension (495 NEXT) Project

#### What's Happening?

Daytime pile driving at the eastern abutment for the new Georgetown Pike Bridge is planned to start on or about May 22 and continue for approximately one week. The pile driving is necessary to build foundations for the future bridge, which is adjacent to the existing bridge and between the on-ramp for northbound I-495 and the Beltway.

#### **What Should Neighbors Expect?**

The periodically noisy work will involve driving steel piles into the earth. When active, neighbors may hear hammer strikes every few seconds.

All construction work is dependent on weather conditions and other factors.

## **What Happens Next?**

Following pile driving at the eastern abutment of Georgetown Pike Bridge, crews will begin pile driving at the western abutment this summer. Work includes completing the abutments and relocating overhead utility lines and a large highway sign. Next, bridge beams will be lifted into place over the Beltway, an activity that must be performed during nighttime hours because the highway below must be closed to traffic for safety reasons. The deck and remaining elements of the bridge then will be constructed.





Steel piles will be driven into the earth at this location, which is adjacent to the existing Georgetown Pike Bridge and between the onramp to northbound I-495 and the Beltway.
