I-495 Express Lanes Northern Extension (495 NEXT) Project

What's Happening?

Crews will be doing pile driving for two bridges under construction as part of the 495 NEXT project.

When and Where:

- Starting on or about November 7 and continuing through November 14, pile driving will occur on the new overpass for traffic traveling to Georgetown Pike from George Washington Memorial Parkway or southbound I-495.
- Starting in approximately late November and continuing through December, pile driving will occur at the west abutment of the new Georgetown Pike bridge.

What Neighbors Should Expect:


Pile driving involves hammering steel piles into the ground to support foundations of the future bridges. When active, neighbors will hear hammer strikes every few seconds.

Pile driving will occur during daytime hours, Mondays through Fridays, with the possibility of occurring on Saturdays if necessary.

This construction work is weather dependent, and may be rescheduled if needed.
